We are now [Champions for Wildlife](#) with a mission to help kids fall in love with wildlife using art through our new Wild for Art educational program. And the American red wolf is one of the main animals we teach about since it only lives wild in our state and is the most critically endangered wild animal in the US.

We have just hired a full-time teacher, Alexis Hinchliffe, who will be developing red wolf curriculum thru a generous donation from Defenders of Wildlife. Lessons will be shared with SAFE facilities and will include our children's film [For the Love of Red Wolves](#) available on YouTube. The [Red Wolf Gallery](#) launched a year ago last May has had over 115,000 photo views. All photos are free to download to bring awareness to our American red wolf. Folks, including students, are using the photos to write children's books, develop lesson plans, write masters thesis, spread awareness on social media and lots more.
